

Additions and Corrections to Cemeteries and Graveyards of Madison, New Hampshire

Page 95 – Gilman cemetery, Arnold – Ward Plot: Recent additions of Jean W. Arnold (maiden name – Ward) 1928 – 2006, and **Marilyn W. Ward 1932 – 2007** (sister of Jean, and buried beside Jean).

Page 201 – Lyman cemetery, Durgin Plot: **Nancy J. Durgin** was not the daughter of Abraham C. & Rebecca (Forrest) Harriman as stated, but was the daughter of Moses & Hannah J. Pierce.

Page 202 – **Roxanna B.**, wife of George W. Osgood, was the sister of Nancy J. Durgin, and daughter of Moses and Hannah J. Pierce.

Page 239 – **Chick, Doris L. (*)**: Doris is located in the Gilman Cemetery at Section H, Row 9 (see page 81). However, her original stone was located in the back corner between Section A, Row 23, and Section B, Row 1 (see page 24).

Page 154 – **Jackson-Emerson Graveyard**: Between James Allard and Minnie, Headstone found and uncovered:

Charles H. Allard
Died March 6, 1875
AE. 34 y'rs, 6 mo.

*We are parted, we are parted,
And I find the parting sore;
May we meet in yonder heaven,
May we meet to part no more.*

Charles H. Allard was most probably buried here, however, see **page 57**, a headstone was also erected in the Gilman Cemetery for Charles H. Allard.
